## John Deere 50, 60 & 70 Series Tank Fill Tube Liner Installation Instructions

Please read the entire instruction sheet before begining installation.

Please refer to your combine manufacturer's operators manual for pertinent safety precautions.

- 1. Remove auger bearing mounting bracket and remove auger from housing.
- 2. Remove any debris from inside the auger housing.
- 3. Insert the Tube Liner into the tank fill tube.
- 4. Position the top edge of the Tube Liner flush with the top edge of the tank fill tube.
- 5. Verify that the liner is rotated to the correct position and the bottom edge is flush with the tank fill tube.
- 6. Snap the two edges of the liner together by pushing the liner toward the tank fill tube walls and pressing along the seam. A putty knife can also be used to help snap the seams together.
- 7. Clamp liner to the tube to ensure it does not move.
- 8. Use the four pre-drilled holes in the liner and supplied 13/64" drill bit to drill through the steel tube. Fasten liner in place with supplied rivets.
- 9. Drill two 13/64" holes on the top side of the liner. The holes should be 1/2" down from the top edge of the tube and 1/2" from the seam on both sides. Install rivets.
- 10. Drill five 13/64" holes holes along edge where steel tube is welded to the base plate and install rivets.
- 11. Drill 3/8" holes through liner for bearing mounting bracket locations.
